HSPT & Admissions Process 2019-2020 Parish and Diocesan Secondary Schools

High School Placement Test (HSPT)

- 1. The HSPT will be administered each year on the first Saturday and Sunday of December. Testing dates for 2019 are December 7-8.
- 2. Registration will occur through STS @ http://wilmington.stsusers.com.
 - a. Registration information will be open to elementary and secondary schools on Monday, September 9 .
 - b. Registration information should be posted on the websites of elementary and secondary schools by Monday, September 16.
 - c. The per pupil registration fee (\$65.00) should be paid online with a credit card or by cash, check, or money order to the Catholic Schools Office. **No additional fees** may be required of a student by an individual school to participate in the HSPT.
 - d. A secondary school which reduces or waives the registration fee for a student must remit the per pupil payment of \$65.00 from the school account to the Catholic Schools Office on behalf of the student.
 - e. Each secondary school will communicate to the prospective student/family the particulars for the day of testing arrival instructions, what to bring, etc.
- 3. A student may test *only* at the school of his/her first choice. No exception may be made by the Admissions Directors or Principals.
- 4. Student answer sheets must be shipped by overnight delivery to STS by the end of the business day on the Monday following the test administration.
- 5. Test results will be forwarded to elementary schools in the Diocese of Wilmington the week of January 6.
- 6. The request for a copy of the testing results from one secondary school to another secondary school in the diocese for a student *must be honored within 24 hours* by electronic transfer. If there is any concern in this regard, please contact the Catholic Schools Office.
- 7. The Practice HSPT for Grade 7 students will be administered at the local secondary school's discretion. The cost for the Practice HSPT will be \$65.00 per student. A calendar of Practice HSPT dates will be provided to elementary and secondary schools.

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Request for a Student's Record

- 1. A letter from each secondary school will be forwarded to the elementary schools requesting records of students who applied for admission.
- 2. The Diocese of Wilmington Confidential Recommendation Form for a student's record, along with supporting documentation, should be completed and forwarded to the secondary school *no later than one week before the start of Christmas break*. For 2019 the deadline is Friday, December 13.
- 3. In addition to the Diocese of Wilmington Confidential Recommendation Form, the following information is also to be provided:
 - a. Final grades for Grades 6-7
 - b. Trimester 1 grades for Grade 8
 - c. Renaissance Longitudinal Report for Reading and Math
 - d. Attendance records for Grades 6-8
- 4. Psychological records may not be requested or submitted. These records are not the property of the elementary school.

Admission Decisions

Admission decisions and HSPT results will be released to parents/guardians on Saturday, January 11, by e-mail. Families who selected to receive HSPT scores via postal service should receive the results in the mail in the week of January 13.

Scholarship Receptions

A list of the dates of scholarship receptions will be coordinated by the secondary schools each year in advance and communicated to elementary and secondary schools.

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
