Re: PreK-4 Progress Report – Trimester 1

Date: October 12, 2014

Through the efforts of the Early Childhood teachers and Sr. William Adele, SSJ, Assistant Superintendent, the PreK-4 Progress Report – Trimester 1 has been revised and standardized. Since all elementary schools currently have a PreK-4 program, it is desirable to have a common progress report in the same manner in which report cards are standardized in Grades K-8.

A few notes about the PreK-4 Progress Report – Trimester 1

- 1. This progress report is only for Trimester 1. A more complete progress report assessing skills across the Pre-Kindergarten benchmarks will be available for Trimesters 2 and 3. The progress report for Trimesters 2 and 3 is in design by Early Childhood teachers.
- 2. The progress report may be issued at the interim of the trimester, the end of the trimester, or both times. It is a local decision of the school but it should be consistent within a school with multiple sections of PreK-4 classes.
- 3. The progress reporting scale has been modified from its prior version. The elements of the progress report remain the same as the prior version.
- 4. In the Teacher Comments section, teachers are encouraged to offer narrative feedback about the student's successes and to indicate any area where the parent may help the child to grow.
- 5. The progress report bears the diocesan crest. Therefore, it may not be edited with additions or deletions in any way. If a teacher wishes to provide additional documentation to parents, the additional documentation should bear the crest of the school.
- 6. The progress report is designed for PreK-4 only. It is not designed for use in PreK-3 programs.

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We are grateful for the work of those involved in this PreK-4 project. Updated benchmarks will be issued along with the revised PreK-4 Trimester 2 and 3 progress report in the near future.

The next meeting of Early Childhood teachers working on this project is Thursday, November 13, 1:00-3:00 pm. The site will be announced in *Principal's Notes*, the weekly memo sent to principals. A site at which teachers may conference call, if their schools are located in the southern end of the diocese, will be selected.
