



DEEDS 3.0 ACCESS:

The Delaware Department of Education (DDOE) has updated their Delaware Educator Database System to DEEDS 3.0. Educators will no longer be able to access their account through the old database system. The DDOE is responsible for credentialing early childhood and K-12 professionals who work in Delaware early childcare centers, public districts, charter and private schools, adult education programs, and prison education facilities. DEEDS 3.0 merges all previous databases into one system for the State.

To access DEEDS 3.0, all Catholic school teachers in the Diocese of Wilmington who currently hold or are pursuing Delaware licensing/certification will need to first obtain an EdAccess/Classlink account from the State.

Please follow the steps below in requesting an account with DDOE and obtaining access to DEEDS 3.0:

- Request an EdAccess/Classlink account with at <https://ssoapply.doe.k12.de.us/#home>
- Select **“eLearning Account”** as the account type. DO NOT choose Non-Public School as this is designated for Home School programs.
- Complete the required information and submit

Then,

- Verify your email address
- Watch your inbox for further correspondence from the DDOE team

Once your account has been verified, you will be able to change your password and access your educator profile.
