- This three-day professional development program will be held at Daylesford Abbey in Paoli, PA and in Washington, DC, with additional virtual programming planned for the 2024-2025 school year.
- Program highlights include visits to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops and the Holocaust Memorial Museum in Washington, DC. There will be funds provided to purchase classroom resources at USHMM.
