ST. ELIZABETH HIGH SCHOOL, Wilmington, DE, seeks qualified applicants for the position of PRINCIPAL beginning July 1, 2024. The high school is a coed, college preparatory school serving 145 students. St. Elizabeth High School and St. Elizabeth Elementary School share a campus comprised of two city blocks with a beautiful Romanesque-style church, and two buildings. The principal of St. Elizabeth High School is called to sustain and advance an established Catholic school in the tradition of St. Benedict. The principal will be a spokesperson and representative of the Benedictine charism in hospitality, prayer, work, and service. As such, this leader is required to demonstrate spiritual and visionary leadership and serve as an educational leader for students, faculty, and parents.

St. Elizabeth High School, with a 1:1 iPad environment, offers a strong academic program, including 12 Advanced Placement courses, dual school enrollment agreements with University of Delaware, Immaculata University, and Wilmington University, a counselor-directed accommodations program for students with learning opportunities, and 98% of graduating seniors attending colleges and universities. The principal will oversee the new Viking Pathways curriculum, which combines traditional college preparatory programs with real-world work-based experiences in the fields of Medicine, Education, Business and Technology. In addition to the extensive curricular offerings, the school offers 18 athletic teams that compete on the freshman, junior varsity, and varsity levels and more than 25 clubs engaging students in co- and extracurricular activities. The school has state of the art science labs, a theater and gymnasium, locker rooms, training facilities, and public athletic fields.

St. Elizabeth High School is accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools and is a member of the Delaware Association of Independent Schools. The school has been recognized as an Apple Distinguished School and has received the Delaware Superstars in Education Award.

The successful candidate must meet the following criteria:

- live as a practicing Catholic
- hold an advanced degree (Master's or higher) from an accredited institution in an area of study that supports the role/ responsibilities of the principal
- hold or be eligible for Delaware or Maryland licensing/certification (Catholic Theology or Ministry degree is exempt from this requirement)
- have a minimum of five years teaching experience at the appropriate school level (Catholic school experience as a teacher/administrator preferred)
