

Technology/STEM Teacher (Full Time)

Job Description:

St. John the Beloved School is seeking a qualified candidate to teach technology and STEM to students in grades Kindergarten through 5th for the 2024 - 2025 school year.

Candidates are expected to plan, develop, and evaluate lessons for basic computer, keyboard, and internet skills. This position will be responsible for teaching internet safety including personal responsibility for technology use, monitoring internet usage for students according to school and Diocesan policies, maintaining and monitoring student usage of computer lab technology, and collaborating with the administration on technology updates. In addition, the candidate will devise and implement STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) activities. These lessons should promote problem solving, critical thinking, collaboration, communication, innovation and creativity.

The ideal candidate will implement intellectually stimulating activities, plan and execute exceptional instruction, communicate professionally with all members of the school community, commit to professional growth, collaborate with parents/guardians to ensure the developmental success of every student, create a safe classroom environment, and cultivate a classroom of inquiry, creativity, and fun. The successful candidate will possess a true passion for working with students.
