***Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:***

**Student Support:**

- Assist teachers in identifying students who warrant evaluation (psychoeducational, speech, occupational therapy, etc)
- Attend meetings/conferences with teachers, parents, and public school districts
- Foster positive relationships with parents/guardians, serving as a resource and advocate for students and families, and provide ongoing communication and support
- Act as a liaison between the school, community agencies, and outside service providers to ensure support and resources for students and families

**Personal and Social Development:**

- Offer counseling to students who are experiencing personal or social issues that impact the educational experience
- Implement programs to promote positive behavior, conflict resolution, and student well-being

- Provide crisis intervention and support for students in emergency situations
- Plan and coordinate workshops for students and staff on various topics such as bullying prevention, time management, positive relationships with peers, planning for the future, etc.

**Develop and Manage Programs:**

- Design, implement, and evaluate a comprehensive school counseling program
- Collect and analyze data to assess the effectiveness of counseling services and identify any areas for improvement
- Maintain accurate records and documentation
- Maintain clear and open communication with students families and administration

**Requirements:**

- Master's degree in School Counseling, Psychology, or a related field from an accredited institution
- Delaware licensure or eligibility for certification in school counseling
- Minimum of three years of experience is preferred
- Clearances on all required background checks
- Experience with counseling techniques, crisis intervention, and student intervention
- Ability to collaborate effectively with students, parents, teachers, school administration, and any other relevant or necessary parties
- Strong commitment to integrating the Catholic faith and values into students' everyday education
