Position Overview

Psychoeducational Testing

- Assist teachers in identifying students who warrant an outside evaluation (psychoeducational, speech, occupational therapy)
- Sit in on conferences to help teacher explain to parents the need for an evaluation. Provide parent with contact information with public school district or private evaluator.
- Attend report meeting with teacher and parents.
- Assist teachers with referrals

Accommodations

- Write reasonable accommodation lists based on reports provided by outside agencies for students who qualify for services.
- Work with teachers to explain the accommodations for students in their classes.
- Monitor follow-through on accommodations and make any adjustments that are needed.

Intervention Programs/Testing Coordinator

- Monitor DIBELS, STAR standardized testing, Heggerty, and PowerSchool to identify struggling students who may need intervention. (Kindergarten Intervention, First Grade Intervention, Reading Assist, Math Assist)
- Monitor progress of students in the intervention programs.
- Oversight of Renaissance and My IGDI's
- Data analysis
- Help with Early Literacy and Early Numeracy Screenings in Early Childhood
- Title I Referrals
- Attend Meaningful Consultation Meetings
